



## Introduction to Skype

### Goals

- Help your learner understand the use of Skype

### Suggested Actions

- **Explain** that Skype is a programme that enables users to make free calls or low cost phone calls over the Internet
- To use Skype you need a headset with a microphone
- **Explain** that if you have a webcam you can also make video calls to other Skype users, this means you can see the other person on the screen while you talk to them

#### Note:

Calls to other users of Skype are free (if they are online)

## Install Skype on your Computer

### Goals

#### Remember

- **Explain...**
- **Let them try it**
- **Practice...**

### Suggested Actions

- **Explain** that to use Skype you must have Skype downloaded from the Internet and installed on the computer
- **Check** to see whether the Skype shortcut appears on the desktop – if not, download Skype

#### Exercise

##### Download Skype

- Ask your learner to go to [www.skypecom/download](http://www.skypecom/download)
- Click on 'Get Skype for Widows Desktop' and follow the steps in the wizard
- **Explain** that this is done only once To use Skype you click on the icon on your desktop

## Create an Account



### Goals

- Show your learner how to create a Skype account

### Suggested Actions

- **Explain** that the first time you use Skype you will be asked to create an account
- Once the account is created you will just need your Skype name and password to sign in
- **Explain** that you are now ready to use Skype

## Adding a Contact



### Goals

- Show your learner how to add a contact in Skype

### Suggested Actions

- **Explain** that to make a call to someone you need to add them as a contact
- **Explain** that the quickest way to do it by typing their name in the search box
- **Explain** the different parts of the contacts page

### Goals
